Not enough information on reliability and the cost of the vehicle are issues

Or a hybrid/plug in vehicle

The Meadows willingness to explore charging stations actually has influenced my thinking on my next car—not only would I be more willing to purchase an electric or plug-in hybrid, I'm more likely to do so sooner. A lack of at home charging options would have otherwise done discouraged me from upgrading my vehicle.
